

Information Communication Technology (ITC) Consultant for The Barbados Revenue Authority

REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

- 1. The Barbados Revenue Authority (The Authority) invites interested eligible *individuals* to submit Expressions of Interest for an Information Communication Technology (ITC) Consultant.
- 2. The purpose of the consultancy is to provide technical leadership for all technology issues, make recommendations for future purchasing and technology needs; keep the ITC Department up to date on new technology changes and uses that would enable it to increase efficiency and reduce costs; install infrastructure and systems including new services and appliance, software and data transfer when required. In addition, the consultant is to provide advice on the execution of patch management and infrastructure consolidation while assisting in policy formulation and application.
- 3. Interested *individuals* are asked to provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the consultancy. In assessing the submissions, consideration will be given to technical experience in projects of similar scope, complexity and technical specialisation; competence in English; availability of appropriate skills; existing commitments and financial capability.
- 4. The successful applicant will be required to enter into a contract drawn up by or in a form approved by the General Counsel of the Authority or another Legal Officer approved by The Authority.
- 5. APPLICANTS SHOULD BE AWARE THAT THE LABOUR CLAUSES (PUBLIC CONTRACTS) ACT CAP.349 SHALL, IN SO FAR AS IS APPLICABLE TO THE TENDERER, APPLY TO ANY CONTRACT MADE IN RESPECT OF THE TENDER.
